

# GREEK ROMAN WRITING AND LITERATURE CURRICULUM

*Writing with History: New Testament, Greece, and Rome uses the history topics Below are the literature recommendations for this schedule, which are broken.*

To stay free also requires comparison of constitutions, utopian thinking, fearlessness about innovation, critical, lateral and relativist thinking, advanced epistemological skills in source criticism and the ability to argue cogently. Preparatory Work All students complete summer work before entering the Lower Sixth and this provides them with an excellent introduction to the topics that we study. Indeed, Ancient Greek is one of the compulsory subjects in Greek secondary education, whereas in France, Latin is one of the optional subjects that can be chosen in a majority of middle schools and high schools. IB Latin is not a soft option and homework duties are not light; pupils are expected to keep up with work set, to maintain a high standard of work, to learn from mistakes and to read around the subject where necessary. Courses may be credited toward concentration only if a grade of C or higher is earned. Students reading these works will learn to examine them based on genre and structure. History, he proposed, is the subject that equips citizens for this. In addition, students will be able to examine in depth the themes of these works, often with the help of critical essays provided in the books themselves. All students are expected to engage fully in lessons, keep up-to-date and to take responsibility for their learning. IB Classical Greek Higher Level Content The language of Classical Greece: candidates study the works of Xenophon and translate an unseen passage from this author in the language paper candidates are allowed a dictionary. The Latin literature of Ancient Rome: candidates have a choice of two out of five themed selections of literature. The course is largely based on reflective reading and writing essays based on text analysis. The classical world offers a particularly rich field for an Extended Essay and candidates can opt to research and write about any aspect of Greek or Roman literature, philosophy, history or culture that appeals to them. The novels have been chosen for their timelessness and their accurate, stunning portrayal of important historical events and the ideas that have helped shape the Modern world. Ancient Greek The Greek language forms the oldest, written literary tradition in the West, beginning with the poems of Homer in the eighth century BC. The Latin literature of Ancient Rome: over two years, candidates will have the chance to study two prose and two verse authors, OR one of each in greater detail; this year's students have studied excerpts from Cicero's *De Imperio*, Ovid's *Metamorphoses*, Virgil's *Aeneid*, book 6, and Tacitus' *Annals*, book 4. We encourage you to read around the subject as much as you can – both for enjoyment and for an academic boost. Specifically, classical civilisation needs to be recognised in the English baccalaureate and given the same governmental support as Latin. Undergraduate degrees are supposed to produce competent citizens. Augustan Rome. Ancient Greek is also still being taught, but not as much as Latin. The chances of admission for these are in line with other courses such as English and history. Classical Civilization A major in classical civilization, also referred to as a classical studies or classics major, provides an ideal foundation for students interested in comparative literature, archaeology, linguistics, and a wide range of humanistic disciplines. The Extended Essay All IB students have to write an Extended Essay 4, words in one of their subjects; they choose the title, research and write it by themselves as part of the IB learner profile. While the Roman empire of the West collapsed, that in the East survived and continued to serve as a home for the production of Greek literature and thought reflecting ancient models and new modes of thought. A Level Latin Content The Latin language of Ancient Rome: candidates will study a range of prose and verse authors with a view to finally tackling unseen passages from authors such as Pliny and Ovid; candidates will also study how to translate from English-Latin although please note that this is NOT compulsory in the exam! Classical scholarship was becoming more systematic and scientific, especially with the "new philology" created at the end of the 18th and beginning of the 19th century.
